For the academic session 2021-22, the feedback from various stakeholders were collected on the syllabus and its accessibility. The activity was carried out on college level and the data was collected from the students, teachers, alumni and the employer in the prescribed format. The analysis of the same is as follows.

In all 62 students filled the form and provided their feedback. Out of sixty two, fifty two students remarked that the syllabus is very good for which the percentage is 83.87%. Whereas 10 students mentioned that the syllabus is good and also the teachers teach that effectively.

Five teachers of the institute gave their feedback on the syllabus. All these teachers mentioned that the syllabus is useful to students and their growth. The feedback collected from alumni also shows that the syllabus would prove beneficial for the students. Whereas out of five alumni three former students suggested some changes in syllabus based on skill enhancement modules.

The principal of the college, in his feedback, showed satisfaction on the syllabus and its implementation in the college by the teachers. He also suggested that there is need for more practical approach in subjects taught.
